China & Pacific-Asia Studies	CAPS has a study abroad semester in China as an integrated and essential component of its curriculum. All CAPS majors are required to attend a course of study abroad at Peking University (PKU or Beida) in Beijing during their junior or senior years; CAPS minors and other eligible Cornell students may also participate in this study abroad semester, along with CAPS majors. In Beijing, we offer participating students a package of coursework and internship opportunities. Participating students will take CAPS 4001 China in Transition, CAPS 4002 Chinese Perspectives on International and Global Affairs, and an appropriate-level Chinese language course in the School of International Studies (SIS) at Beida. These courses, totally 12 credits, are designated by CAPS as required courses for Cornell credit. Participating students may also opt to take any SIS courses as elective for Cornell credit, as approved by the program.
