As office hours fill up quickly, it is best to book an appointment in advance	Students should bring the course title and description; syllabus, if available; information about any prerequisites; and credits.	If a syllabus is not yet available, bring a course description. However, final approval of the course for major credit will require submission of a syllabus.	No formal limit; however students should consult with DUS to determine which specific courses taken abroad can count toward major requirements.	When students return from their time abroad, they should be sure to bring transcripts and syllabi from all courses for which they wish to receive credit in the major. These will need to be submitted to the DUS for final approval.
