If a syllabus for a particular course is not yet available, then the course can be designated as a major-approved elective until which time the syllabus is available – unless of course the course description is quite clear.	There are 7 major-specific requirement slots that students can fill using study abroad credit; these are the 3000+ technical electives, the 3000+ level external specialization, and the major-approved elective (this can be any level).
