Economics	Faculty advisor first (for general approval of plan to study abroad) & then DUS (for course pre-approval).	Go to office hours or e-mail for an appointment.	Students should bring course descriptions, titles, prerequisites, syllabi, reading lists, and number of credits for each course--all in English. Students should list only two courses if going for one semester or four if going for a full year. (If students change their choices once abroad, they should communicate with the DUS via e-mail.)	Ask whether syllabi may be submitted later, from abroad.	Up to 2 courses for a semester; 4 for a year.
